Outreach-Fred stated that Marina is traveling to groups in her area (Stuart, OK) and some groups have no idea about Central Service and the information was well received. Fred stated he would

like to start attending District meetings to share information about Central Service. Mentioned there are approximately 531 meetings in NE area in districts 30, 40, 60 and 90, however only 83 groups donate to Central Service.

Meegan also mentioned the State Conference in Broken Arrow in May and they need volunteers.

Lyn B. was given an opportunity to share about how the IWC bid went in Des Moines, Iowa in February. Lyn shared some of the I.T. problems with Tulsa's presentation and the difficulties with BID manual as opposed to the actual actions of the conference. Tulsa did not win the bid Boston did but Tulsa was encouraged to bid again next year for 2029. The requirements have already been fulfilled for the next bid so another group of women are going to take the lead for the bid next year.
